I have supervised Master students at Norwegian Universities since 1973, and at UWC since 1995.

I have presented papers at different Research Conferences in Norway, Europe (EAERE and EEA) and in South Africa and Venezuela. I have been visiting fellow at Institut für Weltwirtschaft, Kiel, Simon Fraser University, Vancouver and at the University of the Western Cape (1996, 2000).
